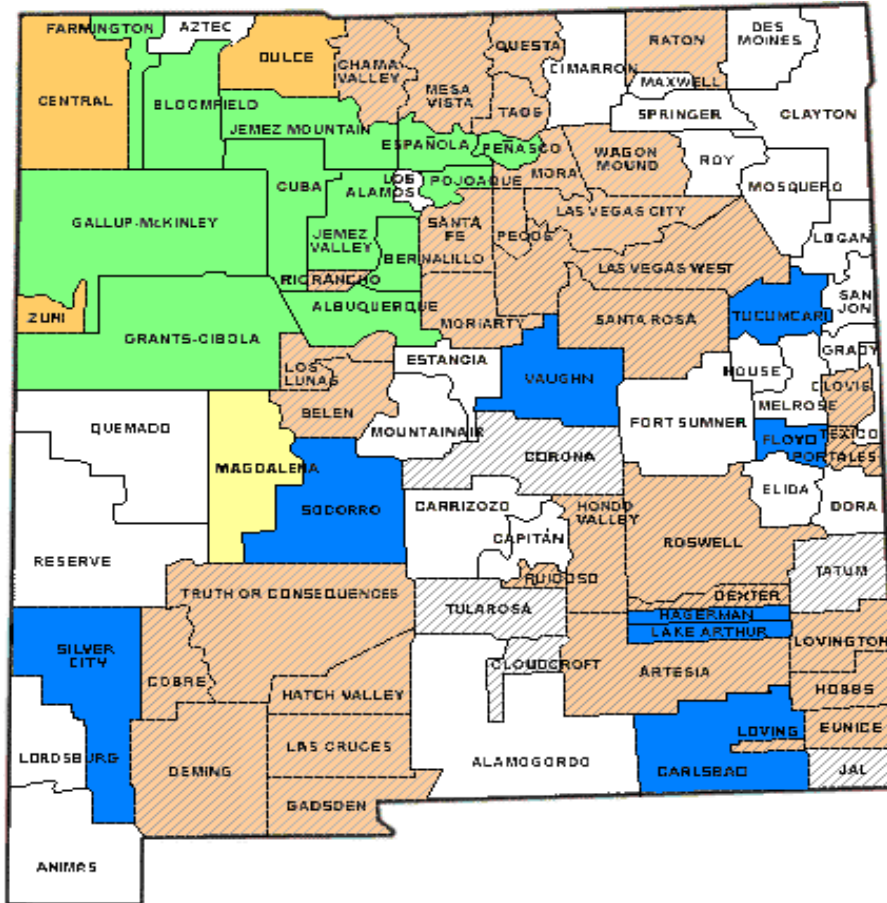

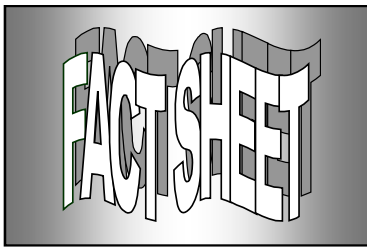

**NM PROVISIONS AND INITIATIVES  
SUPPORTING NM BILINGUAL MULTICULTURAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

1911	Constitutional provisions that maintain a bilingual citizenry.
1941	Senate Bill 3: Spanish shall be taught in all public schools.
1943	Senate Bill 129: To establish a position of supervisor of Spanish in the Department of Education to improve instruction in that language in the public schools.
1968	State Board of Education (SBE) Policy on Bilingual Education ( <b>1<sup>st</sup> one in the nation</b> ).
1969	Senate Bill 270 is passed to maintain the language and culture of the children of the state and to add richness to the curriculum ( <b>1<sup>st</sup> Bilingual Education Law in the nation</b> ).
1971	House Bill 270 (second law) added \$100,000 funding with priority for K-3 to develop greater competence in English, to become more proficient in using two languages, and to profit from increased educational opportunity.  Qualifying students are only those with great limitations in English.
1973	Senate Bill 421-State Bilingual Multicultural Education Law (contains the best of both previous laws): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Appropriates \$700,000;</li> <li>· Addresses equal education opportunity for English Language Learners;</li> <li>· Offers program of English language acquisition;</li> <li>· Includes concept development in core areas - home language;</li> <li>· Addresses language and cultural enrichment to children in school;</li> <li>· Includes linguistic and cultural backgrounds of students in the curriculum;</li> <li>· Expands linguistic and conceptual potentials;</li> <li>· Teaches value and beauty of different languages and cultures.</li> </ul>
1975	State Board Regulation 75-19: Guidelines including requirements to teach language arts daily in the <u>home language</u> of students.
1978	State Department of Education endorsement for teaching English as a second language- TESOL ( <b>1<sup>st</sup> one in the nation</b> ).
1986	State Department of Education approves licensure for Navajo language: i.e., Navajo language competencies for teacher licensure to teach Navajo in public schools.
1987	State Legislature expands the scope and grades of the Bilingual Multicultural Law to the 12th grade with a phase-in from 1988 to 1991.
1989	State Legislature adopts House Joint Memorial 16- English Plus Declaration in New Mexico.
1990	State Department of Education approves endorsement for Native American Pueblo languages.
1992	State Board of Education approves CITE initiative: competency in two languages, one of which is English, for all students in New Mexico's schools.
1997	State Department of Education pilots two-way dual language immersion programs in five NM public schools (Dolores Gonzales Elementary and Longfellow Elementary in Albuquerque, La Mesa Elementary and La Union Elementary in Gadsden, and MacArthur Elementary in Las Cruces).  State Board of Education approves the Content Standards and Benchmarks for Modern, Classical and Native Language.

**NM PROVISIONS AND INITIATIVES  
SUPPORTING NM BILINGUAL MULTICULTURAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

1997	State Department of Education signs the Memorandum of Understanding with the Government of Spain.
1999	State Legislature appropriates funding for pilot schools to implement dual language immersion programs. Ten new schools begin to implement two-way dual language immersion.
2001	State Board of Education approves New Mexico Standards for Excellence (NMAC 6.30.2) which sets expectations for proficiency in English, an understanding of other cultures, and competence in at least one language in addition to English for <u>all</u> students in the schools of the state.
2002	State Board of Education approves a new State Bilingual Multicultural Education Regulation, which expands services to all students in NM Public Schools who choose to become bilingual and biliterate in two languages, one of which is English. This includes Language Revitalization programs.
	NM State Legislature passes the Native American Language and Culture License for teachers.
2003	State Board of Education approves Technical Assistance Manual on April 8, 2003 and the regulation becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
	House Bill 212- Requires instruction in a second language in addition to English for <b>all</b> students in grades 1-8.
	State Legislature passes the Indian Education Act.
2004	State Legislature passes:
	<b>Senate Bill 471a.</b> Bilingual Multicultural Education Act of 2004. (Amends and expands the Bilingual Multicultural Education Act of 1973.)
	<b>House Bill 2.</b> General Appropriations Act of 2004 (Requires PED to annually evaluate effectiveness and use of funds in Bilingual Multicultural Education programs.)
	<b>House Memorial 3.</b> Requires PED to audit Bilingual Multicultural Education Programs
	<b>House Joint Memorial 18.</b> Study of the Feasibility of Testing Students in their Home Languages.
	Public Education Department signs the Memorandum of Understanding with the Government of Mexico.
2005	NM Legislature appropriates \$100,000 to the Public Education Department to develop three new forms for “Prueba de Español Para la Certificación Bilingüe” (Spanish Language Proficiency test for teachers seeking an endorsement in Bilingual Multicultural Education).
	In November of 2005 Secretary of Education approves, the revised Bilingual Multicultural Education Regulation to correspond with the Bilingual Multicultural Education Act of 2004
2006	On February 21, 2006 Governor Bill Richardson issues, an Official Proclamation that declares New Mexico to be a Multicultural State.
